Interclub—Internet—Hints

The Squash NZ SIT (Squash IT) site is up and running for Interclub 2011. Apart from a few teething problems things are going well. There are some great features that are new to us.

What can you see on the SIT interclub?

Logon using your SNZ logon and click on 'Interclub' / click on 'List Interclub Events' and you can see:

Rounds—view your draw, dates, venues, court allocation, playing times

Ladder—see how your team is going

Teams—check out all the teams

Who can enter the results?

Any NAMED team member can enter results for their team

Any person with CLUB COMMITTEE rights can enter results for any of their own club teams

Do's and Don't's

Do update your team captain's details—phone and email address

Do read the online manual available on the SE website or on the SIT home page under Support

Do not enter Interclub through 'Results Entry' module—this has been the cause of nearly all the problems to date

What if I wish to dispute a result?

Click on the dispute button in the results screen and type a brief

reason. The District Administrator will review your dispute and update.
